- c. Instead of increasing the double yellow lines throughout the village, the clerk is to ask DCC for more enforcement of the existing double yellow lines, parking too close to a junction and the no parking zone at the school and junction of Meadow Close.
- d. The clerk is to ask DCC to investigate further a change of parking arrangements on Market Street as suggested by the DCC officer.
- e. The clerk is to write to Simon Spencer to ask if he will be providing any comments other than the officers comments already received.
- f. Community Speedwatch – the clerk is appeal for more volunteers, to date 6 councillors have responded but no members of the public.
